

# Is pleased to host the FoBISIA Virtual Swimming Championships November 1st 2020 - May 16, 2021

Facility: Your own school pool.

**Entries**: Swimmers may enter up to a maximum of 6 individual events, and 3 relays.

Format: The meet will be run as timed finals for all events.

Fee -- No Fee to participate

### **Deadlines**

• Results Deadline -- Due Monday 17th of May 2021 by 23:59h Korea Time Zone

### About the Meet:

For this meet, all competitions will be held at your local area pools. The results of all local virtual meet competitions will be consolidated into one meet with teams and individuals ranked and awarded on their virtual place and scoring.

### Location and Facility:

Location: Competition for the FoBISIA Virtual Swimming Championships will be held locally.

Pool Requirements: Competition may run in either 25 metre (preferred) or 50 metre pools.

 Results from the 50 metre pool will be converted to short course (25M) times for final results using Meet Manager

#### Meet Dates:

Due to the fluid fluctuation of CoVID-19 cases and government restrictions and the various effects it may have on individual regions this competition will run from 1st of November 2020 to the 17th of May 2021. Teams must submit competition details to host. (i.e. ages 9 -12 will swim on the weekend of December 4-6, 2020 and ages 13-18 will swim on the weekend December 11-13th, 2020 etc).

### Eligibility:

To participate in the virtual swim meet, swimmers must be age nine (9) on the first day of the local competition. Aging up restrictions will also apply to the first day of competition for all age groups.

### Local Competition and Procedures and Operations:

**Local Competition:** Teams may swim as an intra-squad (within your own team) competition or an inter-school (two or more schools) competition. All results must have been produced in the competition window from November 1, 2020 - May 16, 2021.

Rules: FINA rules governing the competition starts, strokes and turns, racing and timing will be enforced.

**Officiating:** To ensure that the event is held to an equal standard across all competitions in all locations, a minimum of one (1) head referee and two (2) stroke and turn judges must be present. Teams may use more judges beyond the minimum. Local judges should be familiar with <u>FINA rules</u>. **Please see section 4 through 10 for all rules pertaining to start, stroke, turns and races.** 



**Timing:** All events must be electronically timed with at least one backup button or timed by three watches per lane. **Please see section 11 of the Fina rules for the beginning of all rules pertaining to timing.** 

Schedule of Events: There will be no standard event file for the Virtual Meet. Teams may swim any desired schedule of events in 25 metre or 50 metre pool. However, only the virtual meet age groups and strokes/distances (see Appendix A) will qualify for inclusion in the virtual competition.

**Meet Setup:** Swimmers' birth dates must be included in the meet results or the swimmer will not be included in the virtual competition ranking. Relay swimmers' names must be included in the results. Relays without relays swimmers' names will not be considered. Teams' addresses and head coach information must be included in the meet results team information.

### Submissions Information:

**Maximum Event Limit:** An individual swimmer may swim a maximum of 6 individual events with 3 relay entries. Swimmers who compete in more than 6 individual events should be marked exhibition beyond the maximum events allowed.

If a swimmer competes in more than that allowed number (6) of events, the first 6 events they swam will count and the remaining will automatically be marked as exhibition. A swimmer is only eligible to swim on one relay team per relay event. Swimmers may swim up in an older age group but may never swim down in a younger group.

There is no limit to the number of relay teams a school may enter for any one relay event. (Only the A & B will be considered for points)

Age: The age of the swimmer is automatically calculated as of the first day of the meet being held.

Event Submission: Once a time for a swimmer has been submitted, no duplicate time will be accepted.

**Submission Deadline:** Results should be submitted soon after a meet has been completed, the final day for submissions will be Monday May 17, 2021.

**Submission Procedures:** Results must be submitted to https://fobisiavirtualswimming.sfs.or.kr/ Results must be in .HY3 Hy-Tek Meet Manager meet results export format or a Hy-Tek unlocked backup of the meet database. The results export must include unscored results for all teams.

**Results exported from Hy-Tek Tea3m Manager will not be accepted.** The team hosting the local swimming meet is responsible for submitting the results. However, any team participating in the meet may submit the meet results.

All Results must be carefully reviewed for accuracy before submission to the web site. No corrections will be permitted. All erroneous times or obviously incorrect times will be eliminated from consideration. To maintain the integrity of the virtual competition, please ensure all result times are accurate and/or corrected according to the "Timing" section above.



# Scoring & Awards:

Consolidated Scoring: When all meet results are consolidated, scoring will apply to the top 12 places for relay and

individual events. Swimmers will also receive or be eligible to receive:

- **Top Individual Performance Recognition** -- The top 18 individual performers, despite age or gender, determined by Hy-Tek age-group points, will be recognized at the conclusion of the meet. <u>Relays will not count</u> towards this recognition.
- **Team Awards** -- The top scoring team in each age category & gender will be recognized for their efforts. (9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15-18). In case of a tie, the A 200 metre freestyle relay result will determine the winner.
- Top 12 will score points in all events:

(1st=14, 2nd=12, 3rd=10, 4th=9, 5th=8, 6th=7, 7th=6, 8th=5, 9th=4, 10th=3, 11th=2, 12th=1); relays are double points.

• 3 point scorers per gender, per age group, per event, per team (ex. If your swimmers place 1st - 4th in an event,

only 1st - 3rd will receive points. 4th place will still receive their award for their swim in that event).
